Figure 1 – Open Forms (all at 1: 4)

- I Bowl, with rounded base. Nile silt, with chaff. Red painted. H.4.8, Max. D. 13.2 cm.
- L Bowl, handmade with straight sides. Nile silt, with straw. H. 6, Max. D. rim 7.6 cm
- O Bowl, with rounded base, everted sides, direct rim. Nile silt, with straw. H. 4.8, D. 10.8 cm.
- F Bowl, with flat base, everted sides, grooved rim. Nile silt, with limestone bits. H. 5.5, Max. D rim 14.5 cm
- DD Bowl, with flat base, incurving sides, direct rim. Nile silt, with yellow limestone, chaff. H. 5.7, D. 10.2 cm.
- GG Carinated bowl, with flat base, everted sides. Nile silt, with straw, yellow limestone bits. H. 3.8, D. 11 cm.
- A Tall carinated bowl, with ring base, everted sides, triangular modelled rim. Nile silt, with limestone and chaff. H. 9.8, max. D. rim 11.5 cm.
- E Small carinated bowl, with ring base, everted sides, grooved rim. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff. H. 6.9, D. 12.7 cm.
- M Carinated bowl, with ring base, everted direct rim. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff. H. 5.4, D. 13 cm.
- R Bowl, with ring base, thickened rim. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff, red slip. H. 7.5, Max. D. rim 15.2 cm.
- BB Small bowl, with ring base, incurving direct rim (*echinus*). Nile silt, with limestone. H. 4.1, D. 10 cm.
- CC Bowl, with ring base, incurved direct rim (but not so great as BB). Nile silt, with limestone, chaff, pink slipped. H. 5.7, D. 10.8 cm.
- FF Miniature bowl, with flat base, direct rim. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff, orange slip. H. 2.9, D. 8.5 cm.
- EE Miniature bowl, with cut-off base. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff. H. 4.4, D. 5.2 cm.

- N Deep bowl, with ring base, staright sides, incurved direct rim. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff. Hard fired and some crumpling. H. 12.8, D. 10.2 cm.
- AA Bread mould(?), with flat base, interior bump. Nile silt, with chaff, limestone, sand grains. H. 7.6, D. rim 7 cm.
- Y Bread mould(?), with flat, flanged base, interior hollow. Nile silt, with chaff, limestone. H. 7, D. 5.8 cm.

- V Ovoid jar, with ring base, straight short direct rim. Nile silt, with chaff and limestone. H.10, rim D. 6.5 cm.
- C Ovoid jar, with pointed base, everted direct rim. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff. H. 10.3, D. 7.8 cm
- II Broad ovoid jar, with rounded base, everted direct rim. Nile silt, with limestone, black charcoal, chaff. H. 9.1, D. 8 cm.
- K Small ovoid jar, with flat base, slightly everted (funnel) neck. Nile silt, with limestone, mica. H. 8, D. 4.8 cm
- W Ovoid jar, with small footed base (*saqiya*-pot or *qadus*) (rim lost). Nile silt, with chaff, limestone. H.
- B Squat jar, with rounded base, everted rim. Orange slipped, with brown horizontal bands around the neck and body. Nile silt with limestone, mica. H. 7.2, D. 9.1 cm.
- S Ovoid jar (base lost), with short everted rim. Orange slipped, with brown horizontal bands around the shoulder. Nile silt, with limestone and mica. D. 6.8 cm.
- H Tall jar, with rounded base, inverted direct rim. Nile silt, with straw and mica. H. 14.1, D. 5.3 cm.
- KK Spindle bottle, with small ring base, long neck and modelled rim. Yellow-cream painted, with brown band around body. Nile silt, with mica. H. 19.8, D. 2.7 cm.
- Jar with globular body, pointed base, long slightly everted rim. Nile silt, with chaff and limestone. H.8.7, D. 3.4 cm.
- D Jug, with ring base, one handle, everted rim. Nile silt, with limestone, mica. H. 14, D. 6 cm.

- JJ Jug, with ring base, one handle, everted rim. Nile silt, hard fired, with limestone, mica. White painted, but patchy. H. 13.7, D. 5.8 cm. The firing process had caused the vessel to buckle and collapse in the kiln, with part of the handle almost exploding.
- G Miniature amphora, imitating Rhodian type. With button base, two handes and straight neck and modelled rim. Nile silt, with limestone and chaff. Yellow-cream slipped. H. 14.1, D. 4 cm.
- T Wide bodied jar, with ring base (neck and rim lost). Nile silt, with limestone, mica, chaff. Red slipped. D. of base 6 cm.
- Q Wide bodied jar, with rounded base (neck and rim lost), heavy fabric. Nile silt, with limestone, chaff. Burnt black inside. Max. D. of body 10.8 cm.
- X Bes pot. Wide bodied jar, with rounded base, direct rim. Blobs of clay applied to one side as eyes, cheeks, ears and nose, with impressed dots as mouth. Nile silt, with chaff, limestone. Red painted. H (preserved) 9.5, Max. D. body 9.5 and at top 9 cm.
